

Banner Care

VERY IMPORTANT

- 1 - Do NOT let the ink surfaces rest on each other as they may stick together.
- 2 - Do NOT fold or crease your banner. Rolling will allow it to look much better when reopened.
- 3 - Do NOT put tape or other sticky materials on the ink surface. It will damage the print.
- 4 - Do NOT use caustic agents or solvents on your banner. Window cleaner or soapy water work fine.
- 5 - Store your banner back in the box in which it came in or a similar box. ROLL your banner FACE-OUT for storage.

Hanging Your Mesh Fence Banner On Your Fence Line

Be sure your banner is hung taut so it does not flap in the wind. This is VERY IMPORTANT as flapping in the wind can destroy it quickly. Be 100% SURE to use ALL the grommet holes and tie them tightly to the fence with the uv resistant nylon strapping ties.

- **Why no grommet in the bottom center of our vinyl banners?** It is simply the physics of wind should you hang the banner where there is wind. With the bottom center tied down, wind will turn the banner into a sail and put tremendous stress on the grommets. When the bottom is NOT tied down, the banner will bow at the bottom and allow much of the wind to flow out the bottom placing less stress on the banner, making it last longer. Of course, indoors there is no need to even have a bottom center hole. It is simply the physics of wind flow, wind release and how banners are hung so we can make them last longer for you.
